Application Guidance

The Region's Development Fund exists to provide small amounts of financial support to Scout Groups and Districts that will extend, develop and improve the quality of Scouting provided to young people across Clyde Region.

The fund should be used to contribute to a pool of funding from the Group and District (or other sources) and should not normally be the only source of funding for a particular activity, event or project.

Some examples of possible requests are as follows:

All applications should be able to demonstrate a clear outcome for the Group or District.

Applications should normally be for no more than £500.

A detailed cost of what you are applying for should be attached to the application form and a copy of your Group's accounts must also be submitted. Applications which do not have accounts will not be considered.

Applications can be submitted at any time and will be considered by the Region's Business Committee. The dates on which the Committee meets are in the Regional Diary at www.clydescouts.org.uk

Detail of what you are requesting funding for, including outcome:

The Group's Cub Pack currently has a waiting list of more than 10 young people. We have been successful in recruiting 3 new leaders who are going through appointment and induction. The Group plans to open a second Cub Pack at the start of next session which will null the waiting list and leave more space for additional young people to join.

It's our hope that an additional 20 young people will have joined Cubs by the next Census, increasing our membership by 10%.

To start a new Pack, we need to buy additional resource materials, more games equipment and some craft equipment, the total value of which is £300 (see attached breakdown). The District & UKHQ have given us star-up grants totalling £150, leaving a shortfall of £150.
