

36th Blair Atholl International Patrol Jamboreette.



Clyde Region is making plans for our participation in the 2018 Jamboreette. Participants for the patrols will be selected from throughout the Region. The event will run from 16th July - 27th July 2018.

Selection:

An application form is now available at clydescouts.org.uk for Explorer Scouts who are between 14 and 17 years of age on 16 July 2018.

No Explorer Scouts outwith these age ranges will be accepted as a participant at this event.

All applicants must have registered with and transferred to an Explorer Scout Unit by the time of the event.

Application forms must be completed online by 12noon on Monday 18th September 2017. As it is an online form, we will let your GSL/DESC/DC/Section leader know that you have applied for selection as there will be no requirement for them to sign forms.

The total cost of participation, including training weekends (1 day and 2 weekends) and transport is £370. A £110 non-refundable deposit will be due by Friday 3rd November 2017. The balance of £260 will be due for payment by Friday 30 March 2017. **

The selection will take place at Auchengillan Outdoor Centre on either Saturday 7th or Sunday 8th October 2017 and all applicants must be available for selection on one of these days. Selection will take the form of participation in a number of activities, working together as small groups and an informal discussion about what you could bring as a member of the Unit.

Please encourage applicants to fill in as much information as possible on the online form. Late applications may not be accepted.



Training:

In order to ensure that the Explorers have experience of working together in their patrols at camp, all applicants will need to commit to attending all of the training events on the following dates*:

- » Saturday 17th February 2018, Auchengillan Outdoor Centre.
- » 16th/18th March 2018, Auchengillan Outdoor Centre.
- » 15th/17th June 2018, Auchengillan Outdoor Centre.

The 2 camp based training events are designed to prepare the young people for the Jamboreette and therefore Groups/Units will be asked to provide assistance in providing appropriate equipment for them as well as for the camp.

Home Hospitality:

Applicants will also be committing to offering home hospitality for a period of up to 5 days following the camp (exact dates are arranged to suit the travel arrangements of overseas groups)*. Parents will require to be a member of the PVG scheme through Scouting.

Staff:

Applications to be on the camp staff are available for Network, Leaders and Scout Active Support Members. Dates for staff attending are Saturday 14th - Saturday 28th July 2018. Staff applications are available at www.jamboreette.org.uk. Prompt application before the closing date is recommended.
