
Regional Youth Leads

What is a Regional Youth Lead?

A person aged 18-24 who is responsible for driving youth shaped scouting in their region. Supporting adult volunteers and young people to ensure they are at the forefront of every discussion and decision.

Role Description

- Have creative ideas to make scouting in the Region Youth Shaped.
- Work with National Youth Lead to create a team to work on new youth shaped strategies and be a driving force for young people's voices across Scotland.
- Sit on Regional trustee boards to influence decision making and Champion young peoples voices and ideas.
- Be able to lead conversations and discuss important topics.
- Build relationships with young people and adult volunteers in your region in order to support them.
- Work with regional leadership teams to encourage more youth shaped events and conversations.
- Share opportunities for young people and opportunities for them to get involved in Youth Shaped plans.
- Work alongside your Regional Lead Volunteer and the District Youth
 Leads to support what is going on within your region.
- Encourage and support young people in the region to get involved in all aspects of regional events.
- Create good lines of communication with the districts, your region and Scotland.
